Effective at 4:00 P.M. today, the Denton County District Clerk's Office will temporarily suspend all walk-in services. This includes all walk-in services provided by civil, family, criminal and jury departments.

This decision was not made lightly and is in the best interest of both the public we serve and the District Clerk's Office employees.

We will maintain our normal business hours. Our hard working staff will continue working all mailed or electronically filed case documents, issuance requests for District Court cases, orders issued by the District Courts, and all mailed or emailed records requests.

Further, at this time, jury trials have been cancelled for all District Courts, County Courts and Justice of the Peace Courts through May 8, 2020. Any individuals that have received a summons to report for jury service before May 8, 2020 are no longer required to appear and their service is ended.

We understand that the needs of the public, the District Courts and my staff are of the utmost importance and are being evaluated daily. Our office is in constant contact with the County Judge, as well as Denton County Public Health as it pertains to the safety of our Denton County family.
