Denton County Property Tax Statements Mailing Out Soon

October 18, 2019

The 2019 Tax Year has begun and property tax statements will be mailed in the coming days. The Denton County Tax Office offers numerous options to pay property taxes including:

- e-Check
- Online using Credit/Debit Card (service fees apply)
- By Phone (1-866-549-1010, Bureau Code 336866)
- Bill Pay or e-Box through your financial Institution
- Mail (**U.S. Postmark must be on or before 1/31/2020**)
- Night Drop Box (check website for details)
- ACH or Wire (Contact the tax office for details and instructions)
- In Person

To pay online, go to <https://tax.dentoncounty.gov> and select 'Property Tax' and 'Pay Property Tax Online'.

Ms. French also explained that a customer can go online to enter the wait queue before arriving to the tax office. "Should a customer need personal services, they may check in before arriving at any tax office location by visiting our website and select 'Get In Line Today'. I am very excited that we are working toward providing for future date appointments as well".

A property owner that does not receive a tax statement by November 10th should contact the Tax Office. "It is important that a property owner contact us if they do not receive their tax statement in order to ensure the proper information is reflected in the property tax records", said Ms. French. Property Owners can download a copy of their tax statement from the website or request that the statement be emailed.

All property taxes must be paid by January 31, 2020 to avoid penalties and interest. The Tax Assessor-Collector is restricted from waiving or reducing penalty and interest assessed on a delinquent property tax.
